Board Report – February 2013

1. Ms. Welch is reporting that all of our students who returned to their base school are transitioning very well.
2. Student count in ISS for January – 156 students, December – 157 students, November – 172 students, October 250 students, September – 221, August – 80 students for a total of 1,036 student days for this year.
3. Discipline issues are still way down for this year.
4. All students are working on reviewing and updating their ILP's.
5. Ms. Raiser's Read 180 class is going well, all reading levels are increasing.
6. We have implemented a "Real World Reading" program for all students every Friday.
7. Ms. Welch is continuing her work on Operation Preparation for this year.
8. Mr. Root gave a presentation to the state KMEA conference in Louisville showcasing what he has done with Arts and Humanities at the ALC. Over 100 attended including some college professors.
9. We recently completed a report for the state that goes into a report card for the alternative school. This is the first year that alternative schools have been included in this report.
10. The name of our online curriculum has been changed from e2020 to Edgenuity.
