We are busy making plans for the next school year and working out details. The plan is to have multiple “Pathways” for students to follow through CCHS. Students will have Pathways through high school that will be similar to “majors” or courses of studies where they will be guided to classes that can lead to the opportunity to earn college credits or industry certifications. In addition we are strengthening our ties and collaboration between the CCHS and the Carroll County Area Technology Center.

We have implemented an Intervention and Enrichment time into our schedule called, “Gold Block.” This was started at the beginning of this semester. During Gold Block students that have below a “C” in a class are assigned to interventions that vary from homework help to specific skill tutoring. We also have students that are working on test taking skills especially directed at the ACT, Work Keys and KOSSA. Students that do not need test preparation and have Cs or better in all their classes are allowed to participate in one of the Enrichment Classes that we offer.

#### Student Data

College and Career Readiness. Currently 45 of our seniors are College and/or Career Ready (CCR). These numbers should increase as we will be having 78 students taking the Work Keys Assessment later this month. We also have 13 students that are only one area away from benchmark and will be able to meet the expectation by taking the Compass Test.

Current enrollment stands at 530 students.
