## Tickets:

## Highlights of the Month:

- E-Rate – Working on 470's for next year. This lets vendors know what we are asking for the upcoming year.
- Cincinnati Bell has started wiring Winn with new CAT 6 cable.
- Office 365 will take the place of our current email. The transition will be from Feb. 13-17. Along with new email – which will not look much different than we have now- will be SharePoint and Lync. SharePoint allows the sharing of documents and is org owned. That means we can monitor accounts to keep students safe. Lync is a program that allows users to connect by video.
- A 2013 version of the Program Review is on the website. The 4 areas of program review: Arts and Humanities, Writing, Practical Living and Career Studies, and K-3. Schools will be inserting data, videos, and pictures to show evidence of:
  - The improvement of **quality** teaching and learning for all students in all programs

  - Student **demonstration** of understanding beyond a paper-and-pencil test
