

**Carroll County Alternative Learning Center**  
**Board Report – May 2013**

1. Student count in ISS for April – 171 students, March – 179 students, February – 200 students, January – 156 students, December – 157 students, November – 172 students, October - 250 students, September – 221 students, August – 80 students for a total of 1,586 student days for this year.
2. Staff has been working on plans for the summer learning program and we are looking at which of our students could most benefit from attending.
3. All staff members have been working on reorganizing all of our storage spaces to prepare for the loss of the ISS building next year.
4. We have transformed the old ALC room into the ISS room and the old leadership room into the old ALC room.
5. All testing is complete and we are pleased with the advances shown from the results.
6. Ms. Raisor’s Read 180 class is going well, all reading levels are increasing.
7. Our new “Real World Reading” program every Friday is going very well.
8. We have completed all of our referral meetings for next year and we are ready to begin scheduling of our students.
9. The new Edgenuity Package is now accessible and classes are being built for next year.
10. The maintenance department has been working hard to help us with our need for storage space by building shelves, cabinets, hanging things and helping us move.
