We had a good end of the school year. We have 72 total students College and/or Career Ready. Eighteen students are both College and Career Ready. End of Course testing went well even after the problems at the state level. We ended up being able to test our students on line. All classes not having an EOC had a Final Exam. Finals were held during then last few days of school to keep everyone engaged until the very end.

Spring sports such as Tennis and Track have been ending their seasons with a few students qualifying to compete at the State Track Meet. Baseball and Softball will be competing in district tournaments this week. Other activities, such as Band and Honor Guard have held end of the year banquets.

Summer School. Our goal is to first focus on seniors to get the last few to graduate. For two weeks we will have only seniors. They will continue past the two weeks if necessary. From June 3rd through the 21st we will be having Summer School for the other students that did not pass all their classes. We are using an on-line program that will allow students to work on the concepts that they did not master during the school year. In July we will have three weeks where we will work with students to build skills in Math and Reading. Additionally, in July we will offer students an Elective Class in Agriculture Construction Skills.
