It has been a busy year for training with Special Education Teachers and staff. I thought I would list some of the trainings that have been provided to assist our staff for the final approval from the Division of Learning on our 11-12 Corrective Action Plan, which was submitted on April 30, 2013.

- Individual Education Plan (IEP) training through OVEC consultants and two days of follow up sessions with individual teachers**
- Progress monitoring for students' IEPs were reviewed and training was provided by OVEC consultants and reviewed individually with each teacher once this semester**
- Progress Monitoring on IEPs training was provided for the special education teachers**
- Adverse Effect and Behavior Observations Training was provided by OVEC Consultants**
- Due Process Forms Training was provided when needed**
- Record Reviews were completed by special education staff and administrators in the building. This provided training to them to support our weaknesses and strengths in paperwork. This also will be a part of the internal yearly audit that helps develop the Corrective Action Plan for the 13-14 School year.**
- We had an on-site monitoring visit from the Department of Education in the Division of Learning in April. This will provide valuable information on what we need to be doing next year for the Corrective Action Plan, along with our yearly internal audit.**
