

## Special Education Board Report

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1. Our presentation for WHAS Crusade for Children is Tuesday, March 25. Our focus this year is providing assistive technology in order to foster independence. We are asking for products that will help students work without the assistance of a staff member.
2. The teachers and I are having individual meetings to look over students' progress. We have had some constructive conversations about how students are doing. We are also determining needed resources for this school year and next year.
3. All of the folders that were designated for correction for our Corrective Action Plan have been reviewed by the state. We received information from Kentucky Department of Education that all of these folders are in compliance. We will now be doing record reviews on random folders to see if we have corrected the systemic problems. I feel confident that this record reviews will show the care Carroll County special education teachers take in meeting individual student needs.
4. All the special education teachers are having data meetings to determine what their concentration will be to prepare students for state testing. We are determining appropriate strategies to prepare the students. We will be looking at student work to strategize next steps for instruction.
