

**Carroll County Alternative Learning Center**  
**Board Report – April 2015**

1. Our current enrollment is 21 students – 9 Middle School – 12 High School. Of these, 5 are expelled, 13 are referred and 3 are here voluntarily.
2. Our laptop loaner program has been successful. Our two loaner laptops have been checked out often and used for Edgenuity work.
3. Ms. Woods has been tutoring Math classes 4 hours a week and Math grades are going up.
4. Students are continuing with their robotic projects on Friday mornings.
5. Ms. Welch had a Truth or Consequences Project speaker for our students.
6. All students took the Edgenuity Math and Reading Placement exams in January. Based on these scores, students have been placed in Edgenuity Mypath RTI classes to close the skills gap. All students are making progress in this program.
7. All students have been working on updating their ILP's and all have reached the 100% mark.
8. We have 8 students who have been passing all of their classes and we have been allowing them to tutor the other students and participate in other special projects.
9. We have been meeting with parents to review the third quarter grades, attendance and discipline. We call this the ILPA Team review process.
10. We are making plans for any of our students who do not pass to attend summer school for 6 weeks.
11. Our last painting project for the year is scheduled for May 8<sup>th</sup>.
12. Ms. Welch attended a Counselor's training for one week.
13. We are meeting with Ms. Mefford and Mr. Jury to expand our use of the Tech. School next year in hopes of improving our Career Ready numbers.
