We are getting close to the end of the year, so there are lots of things going on around school. Classes are working to get in their entire curriculum. Students are being prepared for end of the year testing the testing windows are fast approaching. Students will be taking AP tests during May. They will also be taking their End of Course (EOC) assessments in the four areas that are tested. All students will be taking finals during the last few days of the school year.

ACT testing went well. We were pleased with the ACT preparation that we did with the students. We also received a lot of positive feedback from the students about the ACT Prep. Work Keys and KOSSA results are back and the results look good with a 76% pass rate. These results put us very close to our CCR goal. We will only need a small number of students to meet the goal and we will be retesting students as we feel they become ready.

Spring Sports are happening and we have many students involved. We have had many events, even with all the rain delays. In baseball we have had two “no-hitters” pitched. The tennis court area is very nice for our home games including the parking lot getting resurfaced with new gravel.
