1. **Enrollment:** 497 students
2. **Curriculum/Instruction:** An identified area of weakness this year at KWP has been writing instruction. A lot of focus has been placed on reading in the past and we are making great strides. Now we need to balance the ELA curriculum by having a research based writing curriculum. This month the entire staff began reading the book A Guide to the Common Core Writing Workshop in preparation to use the Lucy Calkins Writing Units of Study next year. These units are aligned K-5th grade and with the Common Core. This will bring writing best practices and instructional continuity to our school ensuring that all students have access to a reliable and viable writing curriculum.
3. **Assessment:** Our last round of STAR testing in Reading and Math showed that we have achieved or are a few percentile points away from achieving the district goal of 70% of students being proficient in reading and math. Our goal at KWP is to exceed this goal so we are focused on moving our students even further before the end of the school year.
