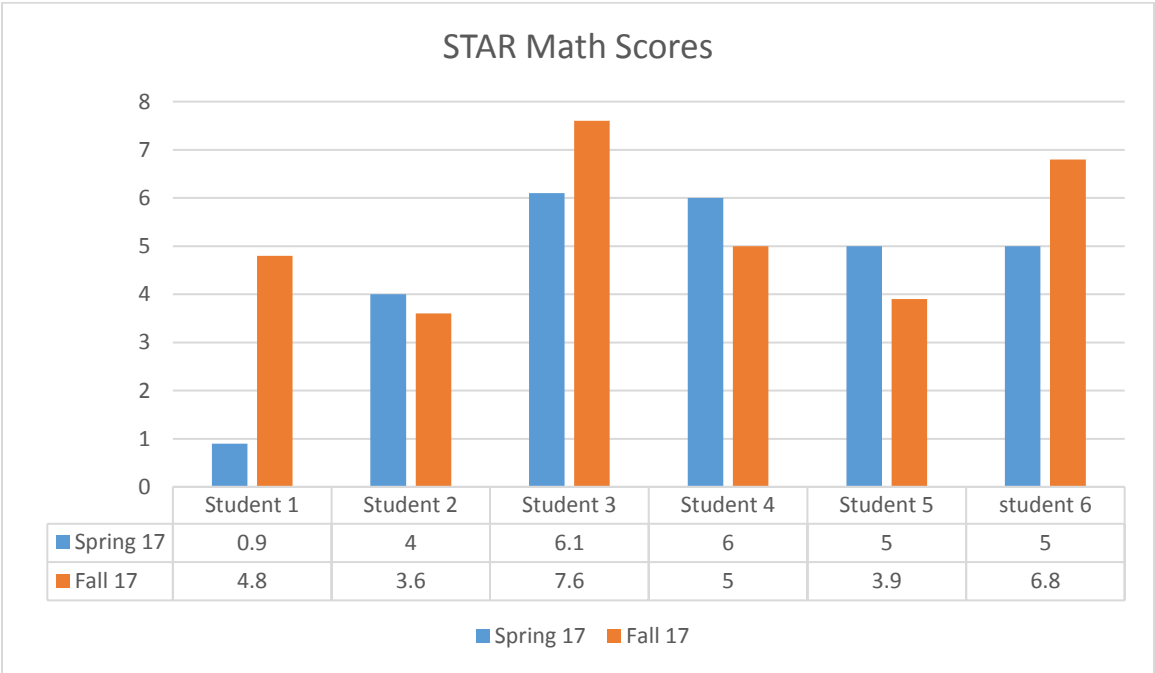


We completed our 1st round of STAR testing (5 middle school students and 1 freshman) and have been providing reading remediation through Edgenuity as well as Read 180 groups based on the individual needs of the student. Additionally, our students who are performing below the 30% are also receiving direction instruction with Ms. Walls. 100% of our students have shown growth or have maintained their current reading level. We will be testing again in November and making adjustments to our literacy plan as indicated by the results.



50% of our students have shown growth in the area of math. While we realize there is skills attrition due to summer break, it is obvious we have some areas of need to address. Two of our lower performing are also lower performing readers. There were a number of word problems in the area of math which our students acknowledge having a difficult time understanding. We have a certified math teacher on staff this year and Mrs. Woods continues to provide additional support to our students one day per week, in the afternoon. We anticipate our November scores to improve and reflect the commitment the students have made to seeking assistance from our certified staff.
