The school year ended well. All, but one of our students that started the year with senior status graduated. The remaining one is working in our Summer Learning program and will be completed before the end of the month. The graduation ceremony went well and the only comments to the school were positive.

Summer Learning is going on everyday. There are about forty students that are coming to school during our June session. In July we will be offering another three-week session. Many of the students attending Summer Learning are there to accelerate, meaning they are working to get ahead or to complete a class during the summer. Several students are taking a foreign language or advanced class. Some students are accelerating in order to fit a class into their schedule or to ensure they are able to take a class that is not offered during the school year. These opportunities are part of our expansion in individualized learning for each student. In July we will be offering lunch through the Summer Feeding Program and a bus will be run in the afternoon.

We still have a few teacher positions open. We are looking for Biology/PLTW and Foreign Language teachers. The number of applicants is much lower this year and we are even looking at teachers from non-traditional routes.

There is lots of activity around school this summer. Football, Soccer and Volleyball are conditioning and will begin practicing fulltime after the “dead period.” Custodians and the maintenance staff are busy with projects. The gym floor is being refinished.
