Board Report- May 2018

1. Our current enrollment is 21 students- 11 middle school and 10 high school. We have 2 High school students who are not under our enrollment but visit us half day. We have 4 students from the middle school who are currently in phase 1 and 2 of returning to the middle school.
2. Our first community service project was extremely successful. We had 10 students who volunteered and painted the bleachers at the fairground. We will be returning to the fairgrounds on Thursday the 17th and Friday the 18th to paint the stage and pageant trailer.
3. The 10 students who are still enrolled with us have collectively earned 53 credits already. That's 5.3 credits per student. They have the ability to earn another 27 credits total by the end of the year. Making that an average of 8 credits per student per year.
4. All of the 8th graders who are currently enrolled with us are on track to begin high school at the traditional school. We have 2 students in grades 9 and 10 who will also be on track to return to the traditional school if they complete the credits offered by the end of the year. 2 of our middle school students are on track to return to the middle school by the end of this year.
