The end of the school year is quickly approaching. We had a round of assessments in April and are currently having another round. JCTC students have completed their finals for their Duel Credit classes. Students taking Advanced Placement (AP) are taking exams in those courses according to the nationwide schedule. We have KPREP, CERT and On Demand Writing assessments all scheduled on one day since each applies to a different grade level and therefore we only disrupt one day. Seniors will be taking class finals next week and underclassmen will be taking their final exams on the last three days of school.

The Academic Banquet was once again a wonderful night. Large numbers of students were recognized. Our community showed their support of our students and our school by again awarding many different students numerous scholarships.

Many activities are winding up for the year. We have many of our student athletes competing in district tournaments. Our Bass Fishing team finished third out of 137 teams in the region and qualified for the state tournament. In track, two of our students qualified for state competition. The band held their Spring Concert. This year they again had a "Dinner with the Pops" format which is a more casual atmosphere. The high school and middle school bands took turns performing while patrons were able to relax and even eat dinner. Various groups are holding their own banquets.

End of year activities are in full swing. With just a few days remaining we have events almost daily. Students and parents have asked for more recognition at graduation. Therefore, we have increased the graduation regalia that students will be eligible to wear during the ceremony. Graduation will be at 2:30 on Sunday June 1<sup>st</sup>.
