Goal 1:

The elementary schools are preparing to kick off the “Kids Read Now” project again this summer. They have been working with Mrs. Ray on this.

The secondary schools are preparing their reading “lists” to send home in May with students. Update: CCMS is partnering with the public library to send actual books home with every student this summer.

Mrs. Ray and I are in the process of developing the system of professional

learning and support for all staff. Last week we meet with administrative staff to discuss the professional development needs of each building and put a plan in place. UPDATE: The plan development is on-going and will be complete prior to the end of June.

In June we will be reviewing the evaluation documents to improve them to ensure they allow evaluators the tools to help staff grow professionally.

Each building is developing a plan to roll out the new standards, including a plan for the vertical and horizontal alignment. These plans will begin implementation at the end of this school year and run throughout 2019 / 2020.

During the course of this school year schools have been developing their instructional processes for their buildings. These will then be used to help all staff, but particularly new staff in appropriate reading and math strategies. UPDATE: CCHS, CCMS and Cartmell will receive training on the “Fundamental Five” instructional process on June 4th. This is the model they will use for the next school year.

During the month of July Mr. Willhoite and myself will be working together to develop our truancy diversion and student barrier reduction plans for the 2019 / 2020 school year.

The social / emotional group has been working to develop and improve our SEL plans and PBIS systems in the district.
