Steps to Improve/Change Behavior

From the April totals above, 5 of the second grade, 7 of the third grade, and 8 of the fourth grade behavior referrals were bus referrals. The total bus referrals for April was 20. One student had two of the three out-of-school suspensions and was referred to counselor.

To improve/change the behavior this month we changed recess, provided more supervision in the cafeteria and we continue re-teaching Cartmell expectations and sending home positive postcards to recognize positive behaviors. In addition, we continue working with parents, implementing behavior plans, and providing mentors. We are also incorporating student specific behavior plans for students with frequent behavior referrals. We are working with students to include motivating rewards to encourage success with the plans.
