

Re-entry Planning: We have been working very hard to secure plans for starting our school year under a virtual and distance learning model. As you can imagine, this has not been an easy task. With the recent switch to Edgenuity for virtual school, Mrs. Rohrer and I will be training with teachers on the following dates:

MAP Assessment Training: All teachers will get MAP training on August 19th. Some will train for 3 hours in the morning and the others for 3 hours in the afternoon.
