Board Report
August 2020**

Virtual School: Due to unforeseen circumstances, the platform we will use for the virtual school model has changed from K12 to Edgenuity. All of the other virtual school components will remain the same. Features such as; teacher support, re-teaching, providing feedback, small group face-to-face as needed, including both supplemental live and recorded lessons as needed will all remain the same.

- **Virtual School Teacher Training:** Teachers from each building have been selected to provide students learning through the virtual school option. Secondary teachers will be attending a webinar on 8/18 for Edgenuity Courseware and elementary teachers will be attending a webinar for PathBlazers on 8/20. All grade level teachers will attend a working session on 8/19 to learn more about the expectations of the district's virtual school, to collaborate on setting student expectations, and to enroll students in their virtual classes.

RTI for Secondary: We are moving forward with upgrading System 44 and Read 180 for interventions at the middle and high schools. This includes a renewal of the programs with the purchase of some updated materials. The staff involved in providing lessons and support will receive training on use of the new materials.

SBDM: SBDM member training is complete. With the exception of 4 members across the district, all other council members have been trained. The remaining 4 members will be completing their required training through an online offering.

New Teacher Training: New teacher training was conducted on August 14th. There were 8 new teachers in attendance. They received a bus tour of various parts of the community and participated in professional learning around relationships, strategies, and creating a culture of learning. In addition, they also received information about distance vs. virtual learning, human resource information, technology use, ELL, and special education services.
