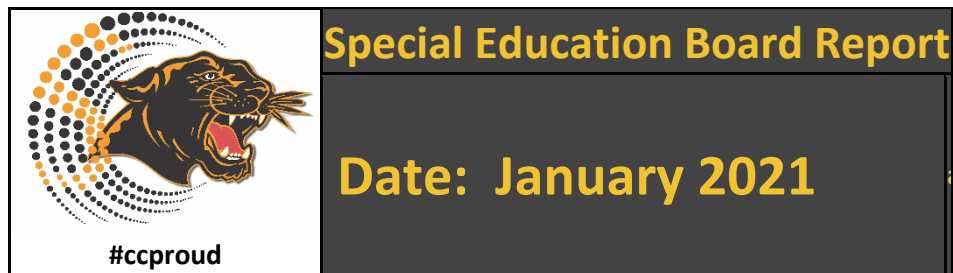


# Carroll County Schools



1. The Special Education Department developed MAP assessment spreadsheets for each special education teacher. The spreadsheets contain MAP scores for each student in special education who was administered MAP. Mr. Sizemore has scheduled individual meetings with each special education teacher to review scores from the MAP assessments. Data discussions will be had during these meetings and each teacher will develop a MAP growth goal with each student for the Winter MAP assessment. Goal sheets will be developed to document the growth goal and steps to make the student successful.
2. The Special Education Department has continued to provide staff trainings. This month, Mr. Stephen Mullins (School Psychologist) and Mr. Sizemore conducted Record Reviews for evaluation training with the Carroll County High School staff. The training was focused on utilizing current student data to help make eligibility determinations for students with disabilities. Protocols and templates were provided to help support the special education teachers.
3. The Special Education Department, along with Mrs. Jeannie Rohrer, has conducted training for the CCMS special education staff regarding data collection for reading intervention supports. The CCMS staff have utilized the Lindamood-Bell reading program to support students with special needs who are struggling readers. Mrs. Rohrer provided staff with training on record tracking and making instructional decisions based upon the formative assessments conducted weekly.
4. Mr. Sizemore has been working with the Central Office to assist with the Comprehensive District Improvement Planning Committee (21-22). The focus has been establishing a Multi-Tiered System of Support (MTSS) for the district focusing on Academic Response to Intervention (RTI) and Behavior supports in the form of Positive Behavior Intervention System (PBIS). This work will be utilized during the planning for the 21-22 CDIP committee work.
