Here is a rundown of items going on currently at Cartmell:

1. We currently have an enrollment of 444.
2. Curriculum / Instruction / Assessment – At the end of Feb. we completed our STAR diagnostic assessments to look at student progress between Jan. 1 and the end of Feb. We have met with our teaching staff to formulate our plan for instruction moving forward. We are working to make sure our students are as prepared as possible to tackle K-Prep at the end of the year.
3. The Leader in Me – We will be having an on-site coaching visit in April. In addition, our PLP coach Amy Shinn will be working with our Personalized Learning Plan Team to up-date our school's plan for the KidFriendly Learning Grant.
4. Achieve3000 – Student and teacher usage continues to grow. We have recognized our students who are demonstrated growth in lexile level based on the program. At the end of each month student lexiles will be adjusted again. We are looking forward to greater growth this month than we have had previously.
5. Cincinnati ArtReach will be here to perform the "Fredrick Douglas Story" on Friday, March 21st at 1:30 PM. This will be an excellent opportunity for our students.
