Strive to Be Awesome. She discussed the testing scores and assessments. Cartmell has focused on literacy along with writing. Mrs. Ray discussed the co-teaching classrooms within Cartmell and how that is a focus for the school as well. The School Improvement plan is a living document that is constantly changing with the 30-60-90 day plans that are constantly changing. The small group champion block is constantly changing for the students based on assessments and needs of the students. Enrichment also happens during this time to challenge other students that are moving at higher levels. Student engagement in mathematics, from concrete, representational, to abstract, this has been implemented throughout all the grades. This year Cartmell went to self-contained and as we went to self-contained the teachers have had a lot of integrated training within the school to feel comfortable with teaching those subjects that they haven't taught for some time. We also have teachers observing teachers as a professional development piece for the teachers. Mrs. Ray presented all components to the board and there was an open discussion between the Board and the Cartmell SBDM Committee.
