2. 5:10p-5:50 Presentation of Carroll County High School SBDM Council Mr. Stephens began the presentation by introducing his SBDM Council that was present. Ms. Rachel Mefford, Mr. Bill Varble (teacher representative), Lisa Weedman (teacher representative), Magali McCarty (parent representative), Ms. Ashley Webb (instructional coach), Mr. Mark Willhoite (assistant principal). Mr. Stephens presented the required data within his PowerPoint and discussed the different programs that they have implemented within the high school and the opportunities available for the students. Mr. Stephens also discussed the ICU program. The board had questions about the ICU program, the implementation, how it was utilized, and the effectiveness of the program.
